



Cleaning of Human Waste Policy October 2025 (No Updates)

In the event of human waste such as vomit, diarrhoea, faeces, blood needing to be cleaned and sanitised the following procedure must be followed.

- The person handling the spillage must wear disposable gloves and a disposable plastic apron.
- All children should be appropriately ushered away from the area, to avoid any potential germs from spreading and whilst the area is thoroughly cleaned.
- All spillage material will be removed with paper towels/disposable cloths. These materials and will be placed into a bin bag.
- Disinfectant will be applied to the area and left before wiping according to manufacturer's instructions. Where possible staff should use a bleach-based formula if there are any concerns related to Norovirus infection. Spray bleach-based formula is available from the housekeeping team/store.
- All disposable gloves, aprons, towels and cloths will be placed into a plastic bag, which is then sealed and placed directly into external waste containers.
- Hands are thoroughly washed using soap and water after cleaning has been completed.
